SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION

AND

AMENDMENT TO DECISION AND DIRECTION OF  
ELECTION

*June 16, 1944*

On May 18, 1944, the National Labor Relations Board, herein called the Board, issued its Decision, Direction of Election and Order in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> On June 13, 1944, the Board received a stipulation of all the parties herein, informing the Board that the chief maintenance man and welder in the Oil City Division of the Company, who was included in the unit found appropriate in our Decision and Direction of Election herein, is employed at the Oil City power station and is, therefore, presently represented under a collective bargaining agreement between the Company and International Brotherhood of Firemen and Oilers, A. F. L. For this reason the parties agree that this employee should be excluded from the unit found appropriate herein. Since, in our Decision, we found that employees of the Oil City power station are not a part of the appropriate unit herein, we shall accept the stipulation of the parties and exclude the chief maintenance man and welder in the Oil City Division from the unit.

The parties further stipulated that the Company employs no chief foreman in its Johnstown Division, that the record is inaccurate in so describing a certain employee, and that the proper title of the said employee is "steam foreman in the Phillipsburg District of the Johnstown Division." The parties agreed that the Decision and Direction of Election and the official transcript should be corrected to reflect the correct title of this employee. The stipulation is accepted and corrections are hereby ordered in accordance therewith.

**AMENDMENT TO DECISION AND DIRECTION OF  
ELECTION**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED in accordance with the above findings, that the words "Chief foreman" in the last paragraph of page 7 of our Decision and Direction of Election be deleted and that the words "steam foreman in the Phillipsburg District of the Johnstown Division" be substituted therefor; that paragraph 2 of page 8 of said Decision and Direction of Election be deleted and that paragraph 4 of page 8 be deleted and that the following paragraph be substituted therefor:

We find that all production and maintenance employees in all four of the Company's divisions, including district representatives, district supervisors, district storekeepers, garage supervisors at Johnstown, service foremen, steam foreman in the Phillipsburg District of the Johnstown Division, gas and steam foreman in the Clearfield District of the Johnstown Division, and watchmen, excluding the employees at the Oil City power station in the Oil City Division, clerical employees, armed guards, chief linemen in the Bradford Division, line foremen, and all other supervisory employees with authority to hire, promote, discharge, discipline or otherwise effect changes in the status of employees or effectively recommend such action, constitute a unit appropriate for the purposes of collective bargaining; within the meaning of Section 9 (b) of the Act.
