SECOND AMENDMENT

TO

DECISION AND DIRECTION OF ELECTIONS

June 26, 1944

On May 31, 1944, the National Labor Relations Board issued a Decision and Direction of Elections in this proceeding¹ and on June 22, 1944, an amendment thereto,² wherein, *inter alia*, the Board provided for an election to be held among outside truck drivers, ram truck operators, and gasoline station attendants employed in the trucking section of the traffic, stores, reclamation, and trucking division of the manufacturing department of Caterpillar Military Engine Company, Decatur, Illinois, herein called the Company, to determine whether these employees desired to be represented, for the purposes of collective bargaining, by Teamsters, Chauffeurs & Helpers Union, Local Union 279, A. F. of L., herein called the Teamsters, or by United Farm Equipment & Metal Workers, C. I. O., or by United Automobile Workers of America, A. F. of L. The foregoing labor organizations and the Company have requested that the Board strike from its description of this voting group the words "employed in the trucking section of the traffic, stores, reclamation, and trucking division of the manufacturing department."³ We shall grant the request.

³ The request for the change in the description of the voting group is based upon the transfer of employees concerned to other departments of the plant. International Association of Machinists, claiming to represent employees of the Company in a residuary group, joined in the request.

The Board hereby amends its Decision and Direction of Elections, as amended, by striking from the description of the voting group for outside truck drivers, ram truck drivers, and gasoline station attendants the words "employed in the trucking section of the traffic, stores, reclamation, and trucking division of the manufacturing department."
