Dear Mr. Heltzer:

This is to inform you of my substitution for Maya and Associates, P.C. as Counsel to Atlantic Veal and Lamb, Inc. ("Atlantic Veal") in the above-referenced matter, and to respectfully request, on behalf of Atlantic Veal, a further extension of time within which to file Cross-Exceptions to the Counsel for the General Counsel's Exceptions filed in the above-referenced matter, from what I understand is the present due date of today, to next Wednesday, September 5, 2007.

I offer the following in support of this request, for your consideration: I am a sole practitioner and, although I was a counsel of record in the underlying unfair labor practice case (the instant matter relates to a Compliance Specification Proceeding before Administrative Law Judge Raymond Green) and appeared at the very outset of the Compliance Specification Proceeding, I have had no further involvement since the commencement of the Compliance Specification Proceeding - I left my law practice in the Metropolitan New York area (where the client also is situated) prior to the commencement of the Compliance Specification Proceeding, and consequently referred this matter to my Son, Bryan Carmody, Esq., and the law firm with which he was associated at the time, Maya & Associates. At approximately 5:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time yesterday afternoon, I was informed that, due to my Son's disassociation from Maya and Associates over the course of the preceding week, he had just been informed by Maya and Associates that their firm had placed a "lawyer's lien" on the Atlantic Veal file in their possession, and that the file therefore would not be made available to my Son until the payment of outstanding legal fees has been satisfied. I have been asked by Atlantic Veal to re-appear on

their behalf and assume the responsibility for the filing of the Cross-Exceptions. Consequently, to allow time to obtain the requisite file materials, familiarize myself with the intervening proceedings and the General Counsel's Exceptions, and prepare Cross-Exceptions, I am asking for an extension until next Wednesday, September 5th (considering that Monday is the Labor Day Holiday). It is my understanding that Maya and Associates had requested a second extension of time within which to file the Cross-Exceptions, from today (which I believe is the present due date) until the day after tomorrow, Friday, August 31st. As mentioned, I am seeking an extension to next Wednesday, rather than this Friday, for the reasons explained (I am not certain of the basis for the second extension request submitted by Maya and Associates).

I attempted, unsuccessfully, to reach Kathy Drew King, Counsel for the General Counsel, the first thing this morning to ascertain her position concerning this request; however, I believe that Ms. King would not oppose this request since it is my understanding that Atlantic Veal had consented to several extension requests submitted by Ms. King in connection with the filing of the General Counsel's Exceptions. I will inform you, directly, of Ms. King's position relative to this request promptly upon being so informed.

Thank you in advance for your consideration of this request.
