**COUNSEL FOR THE GENERAL COUNSEL'S
REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATION**

Pursuant to § 102.46(j) of the Board's Rules and Regulations, Counsel for the General Counsel seeks permission to file a Brief in Support of Exceptions not to exceed 85 pages. In support of this request, Counsel for the General Counsel submits that the hearing in this matter lasted 14 days, resulting in over 2,000 pages of transcript testimony and hundreds of exhibits. Moreover, this matter involves many intricate issues including the discharge and discipline of union activists, violations under *Bill Johnson's Restaurants v. NLRB*, 461 U.S. 731 (1983), and *BE&K Construction Co., v. NLRB*, 536 U.S. 516 (2002), numerous § 8(a)(1) allegations, including ten instances of interrogation pursuant to *Johnnie's Poultry Co.*, 146 NLRB 770 (1946), and a request for a bargaining order pursuant to *NLRB v. Gissel Packing Co.*, 395 U.S. 575 (1969). Pursuant to an order dated October 22, 2007, Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's decision in this matter are currently due at the Board on December 3, 2007. Thus, to fully and appropriately address all of the issues presented,

Counsel for the General Counsel seeks permission to exceed the 50-page limitation set in § 102.46(j) of the Board's Rules and Regulations.
