NLRB Mobile brings access to NLRB case information and decisions to smartphones

The National Labor Relations Board today announced the launch of NLRB Mobile, a web-based mobile application that delivers recent cases, decisions, news, updates, case search and other information about the NLRB to web-enabled devices.
