The Board granted the Acting General Counsel's Motion for Default Judgment based on the withdrawal of the Respondent's answers to prior complaints, and in the absence of good cause being shown for the failure to file an answer to the fourth amended consolidated complaint, and deeming the allegations in the fourth amended consolidated complaint to be admitted as true. Charge filed by United Food and Commercial Workers Union, Local 880. Chairman Liebman and Members Pearce and Hayes participated.
