Dear Counsels:

This is in response to Respondent's Reply Brief in Support of Its Exceptions to the Decision of the Administrative Law Judge, which you e-filed on November 18, 2010.

Your Reply Brief consists of 11 pages. In this regard, Section 102.46(h) of the Board's Rules and Regulations requires that "any reply brief . . . shall not exceed 10 pages." Further, it appears Respondent's reply brief addresses answering briefs filed by counsel for the Acting General Counsel and the Charging Party. Thus, you may file two briefs of 10 pages each, one responding to the Acting General Counsel's answering brief and one responding to the Charging Party's answering brief, but you may not submit one reply brief of more than 10 pages. Also, Section 102.46(j) of the Rules prohibits the combining of briefs. Based on the foregoing, I am unable to transmit your Reply Brief to the Board for consideration.

In the event you desire to file a Reply Brief that conforms to the Board's Rules you may do so. Thus you may file one or two Reply Briefs, as noted above, but in no event should either Reply Brief exceed 10 pages in length. The due date for such conformed briefs is **no later than Friday, November 26, 2010**. No extensions will be granted for the resubmission of Reply Briefs.
