BOARD COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT**


The parties in this matter jointly move the Board to remand these proceedings, which have been transferred to and continued before the Board pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision and recommended Order (ALJD) which issued September 24, 2009, and is reported at JD(SF)-29-09, to the Regional Director for Region 28 of the Board (Regional Director) for the purpose of effectuating compliance with the parties' proposed Board compliance agreement.

Subsequent to the issuance of the ALJD in this matter, the parties entered into a compliance agreement resolving all issues in this matter. Respondent has agreed that it will, if this motion is granted by the Board, comply with the parties' compliance agreement, which


provides a make whole remedy for certain employees who are entitled to receive backpay and post a Notice to Employees.

Based on the foregoing, the parties jointly move that this matter be remanded to the Regional Director for the purpose of effectuating the terms of the Board compliance agreement.
