SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

A controversy having arisen over the amounts of backpay due the discriminatees under the terms of the Decision and Order¹ issued by the National Labor Relations Board on February 25, 2008, and enforced by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, the Regional Director for Region 22, on August 31, 2009, issued a Compliance Specification and Notice of Hearing. Pursuant thereto, a hearing was held before Administrative Law Judge Steven Davis.

Thereafter, on November 12, 2009, Administrative Law Judge Steven Davis issued his Supplemental Decision and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge determined the amounts of backpay due the discriminatees and recommended that the Respondents pay such amounts.

No statement of exceptions having been filed with the Board, and the time allowed for such filing having expired,

Pursuant to Section 10(c) of the National Labor Relations Act, as amended, and Section 102.48 of the National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations, the Board adopts the findings and conclusions of the Administrative Law Judge as contained in his Supplemental Decision, and orders that the Respondent, North American Linen, LLC, its officers, agents,


