DECISION AND CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

The National Labor Relations Board has considered determinative challenged ballots in a mixed manual and mail ballot election held November 17 through December 10, 2010, and the hearing officer's report recommending disposition of them.¹ The election was conducted pursuant to a Stipulated Election Agreement. The revised tally of ballots shows 28 ballots cast for and 25 ballots cast against the Petitioner, with 2 void ballots and 6 challenged ballots, a sufficient number to affect the results.

No exceptions have been filed to the hearing officer's report within the time provided. Accordingly, the Board adopts the hearing officer's findings and recommendations,² and finds that a certification of representative should be issued.

¹The mail ballot portion of the election was conducted from November 17 through December 10, 2010. The manual voting portion of the election was conducted on November 30, 2010.

²The hearing officer sustained the challenges to the ballots of Teresa Mathews, Stacy Dobrinsky, Eileen Lucas and Emily Snyder. Accordingly, she found there was no need to resolve the challenges to the ballots of Megan Robertson and Mark Brice, as these ballots were no longer determinative.


