Dear Mr. Heltzer:

On October 26, 2011, Respondent filed a motion seeking limited reconsideration of the Board's order with respect to the Notice reading remedy. The Region agrees with the Board that the Notice reading is warranted in this case given the nature of the violations and the procedural history of the case. However, it is true, as Respondent contends, that Mr. Wiese has already read the District Court's order in connection with the 10(j) which issued in September 2009. Additionally, the parties have since reached a collective-bargaining agreement which was unanimously ratified by the employees. Further, Respondent has indicated that it does not intend to file exceptions to the Board's decision in the above-referenced case. For these reasons, and based on the specific circumstances present here, including the fact that Respondent has already read to employees the District Court's order, the Region does not oppose Respondent's motion.
