**MOTION TO FILE OVERSIZE ANSWERING BRIEF TO RESPONDENT'S
EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT**


Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the National Labor Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended Counsel for the Acting General Counsel moves for permission to file a brief not to exceed 100 pages in answer to Respondent's exceptions and brief in support thereof.

On October 17, 2011, ALJ Kocol issued his Decision and Recommended Order ("ALJD") in this matter. On December 2, 2011, Veritas Health Services, Inc. d/b/a Chino Valley Medical Center ("the Respondent") moved for permission to exceed the 50-page

limit set forth in Section 102.46(j). On December 6, 2011, the Associate Executive Secretary granted Respondent's motion to exceed the page limitation, allowing a brief not to exceed 100 pages. On December 29, 2011, Respondent filed 83 exceptions and, on December 30, 2011, Respondent filed a 99-page brief in support of its exceptions.

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel moves for permission to file an oversize brief, not to exceed 100 pages, in answer to Respondent's exceptions based upon the length of the recommended decision and order, the voluminous record, the quantity of exceptions filed and the length of Respondent's brief in support of its exceptions. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel has contacted Counsel for Respondent and Charging Party United Nurses Associations of California/Union of Health Care Professionals, NUHHCE, AFSCME, AFL-CIO and neither party opposes this motion.
