CORRECTED ORDER

Service Employees International Union Local 32BJ's (Local 32BJ's) request for review of the Regional Director's Decision and Direction of Election is granted as it raises substantial issues regarding whether there is a successor bar to the filing of the petition. The Regional Director's denial of Local 32BJ's motion to intervene is to be held in abeyance by the Regional Director pending a determination on whether the petition should be dismissed because there is a successor bar. Accordingly, this case is remanded to the Regional Director for further consideration in light of UGL-UNICCO Service Company, 357 NLRB No. 76 (2011).
