**Unopposed Motion by

to Extend the Due Date for Both Cross-Exceptions and Answering Briefs**

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel joined by Charging Parties United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union and its Local Union 14425 respectfully request the Board to extend the filing date for both cross-exceptions and answering briefs to Friday, July 13, 2012. On June 10, 2012, counsel for the Respondent Employer represented that the Respondent does not oppose this motion.

1. On May 16, 2012, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Keltner W. Locke issued his Decision (ALJD.) Under the Board's Rules and Regulations exceptions to the ALJD were due by June 13, 2012; Respondent filed exceptions. Any cross-exceptions or answering briefs are now due June 27, 2012. This motion requesting an extension of the

due date for both cross-exceptions and answering briefs until July 13, 2012, only seeks to extend the filing due date by 16-days.
