ACTING GENERAL COUNSEL'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER  
RESPONDENT'S EXCEPTIONS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S DECISION

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel requests an extension of time to answer Respondent's Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Decision from July 20, 2012 until August 20, 2012. In support of this motion, the Acting General Counsel states:

1. Respondent filed Respondent's Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judges Decision and a Brief In Support of Respondent's Exceptions on July 20, 2012.
2. Pursuant to 102.46(d)(1) of the Board's Rules and Regulations, the Acting General Counsel has until August 3, 2012, which is 14 days from when the exceptions and supporting briefs were filed, to file an answering brief to the Respondent's Exceptions and Brief In Support of Exceptions.
3. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel has been assigned a trial in Escanaba, Michigan, scheduled to begin on August 7, 2012. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel,

whose office is located in Indianapolis, will be traveling to Escanaba, Michigan the week of July 30, 2012 in preparation for the trial and the week of August 6, 2012 for the hearing.

4. Counsel for the Acting General Counsel seeks an extension to, and including, Monday, August 20, 2012 to file its answering brief to Respondent's Exceptions and Brief In Support of Exceptions.

5. Respondent's legal counsel Paula G. Maynes and Charging Party's legal counsel John Hollis have been contacted and made aware of the Acting General Counsel's intent to file a motion for additional time and neither Ms. Maynes nor Mr. Hollis opposes the motion. .
