DECISION AND CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTION

The National Labor Relations Board has considered objections to an election held November 19, 2012, and the hearing officer's report recommending disposition of them. The election was conducted pursuant to a Stipulated Election Agreement. The tally of ballots shows 173 eligible voters, 64 ballots cast in favor of withdrawing the authority of the bargaining representative to require, under its agreement with the Employer, that employees make certain lawful payments to the Union in order to retain their jobs, with 1 ballot cast against the proposition, and 4 challenged ballots, an insufficient number to affect the results.

No exceptions have been filed to the hearing officer's report within the time provided. Accordingly, the Board adopts the hearing officer's findings and recommendations, and finds that a certification of results of election should be issued.

CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTION

IT IS CERTIFIED that a majority of the employees eligible to vote has not voted to withdraw the authority of International Brotherhood of Trade Unions, Local 713, to require, under its agreement with the Employer, that employees make certain payments to the Union in order to retain their jobs, in conformity with Section 8(a)(3) of the Act, as amended.
