This office is counsel to Respondent, Local 560, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, in the above-referenced matter.

On or about April 11, 2013, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel, filed Motion for Summary Judgment. The basis for Acting General Counsel's Motion is ALJ Lauren Esposito's recommended findings in Case Numbers 22-CC-068160 and 22-CC-071865. Local 560 has timely filed Exceptions to the ALJ's recommended findings, with resolution of the Exceptions currently pending. Action on Case No. 22-CC-01522 requires determination and order that Respondent, Local 560, violated the terms of the Settlement Agreement, and such conclusion remains unsettled and pending before the Board.

Respondent, Local 560, believes Acting General Counsel's Motion for Summary Judgment is premature, and for this reason should be pended to await the Board's action on Local 560's Exceptions.
