This will acknowledge the receipt in this Office on July 10, 2013 of the Respondent's brief in support of its exceptions. No exceptions were filed on behalf of the Respondent. Per telephone conversation with paralegal Linda Allen in this Office, Mr. Samuel Wenocur indicated that the exceptions are the bold headings on pages 3 and 11 of the brief in support of the exceptions. These purported exceptions are procedurally deficient and are rejected.


The Respondent's purported exceptions fail to comply with the requirements of Section 102.46(b)(1) of the Board's Rules and Regulations. The relevant part of Section 102.46(b)(1) provides:

"Each exception (i) shall set forth specifically the questions of procedure, fact, law, or policy to which exception is taken; (ii) shall identify that part of the administrative law judge's decision to which objection is made; (iii) shall designate by precise citation of page the portions of the record relied on; and (iv) shall concisely state the grounds for the exception."

The Respondent's purported exceptions fail to state with any specificity the alleged errors in the judge's findings, recommendations, and conclusions, and do not set forth the portions of the record or the evidence relied on in support of the exceptions. Accordingly, the Respondent's purported exceptions contained within its brief in support of exceptions will not be forwarded to the Board for consideration.

The Respondent may conform its exceptions to meet the requirements set forth above, and re-file the exceptions with the Board in Washington D.C. by **July 12, 2013.**
