Dear. Mr. Shinnars:

I write on behalf of the General Counsel to request an 8-day extension of time to file an answering brief to Respondent's exceptions to Administrative Law Judge John J. McCarrick's decision. The General Counsel's answering brief to Respondent's exceptions is currently due on November 18, 2013. General Counsel requests that the deadline be moved to November 26, 2013.
