**OPPOSITION TO RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE EXCEPTIONS TO THE ALJ'S DECISION AND ORDER**

Counsel for the General Counsel hereby opposes Respondent's request for an extension of time to file exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Michael Rosas's decision in the instant matter. However, the General Counsel will agree to a two-week extension to accommodate Respondent (until Dec. 18, 2013).

Generally, a party must file exceptions to an ALJ's decision within 28 days from the date of service of the order transferring the case to the Board. *NLRB Rules and Regulations*, § 102.46(a). The order transferring this proceeding to the Board issued on November 6, 2013. Respondent has requested a 61-day extension to file exceptions, which the General Counsel contends is excessive and gratuitous. Respondent did not state any reasons for its lengthy request.

Respondent has requested two prior extensions of time in this matter. First, it was granted a 4-week postponement for the start of the hearing. Second, Respondent was

granted a 26-day extension of time to file post-hearing briefs. As such, Respondent has already been accommodated multiple times in its requests for extensions in this matter. The General Counsel contends that it and the discriminatees will be unduly prejudiced if further extensions of time are granted. However, as stated above, the General Counsel will agree to a two-week extension of time.

Finally, the General Counsel notes that it was not served with Respondent's request for an extension of time and only learned of the request from counsel for the Charging Party on November 19, 2013. Section 102.46(a) of the Board's Rules and Regulations requires that a party requesting an extension of time to file exceptions must do so in writing and copies thereof must be served promptly on the other parties. *Id.*
