ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

October 25, 1939

A petition, pursuant to Section 9 (c) of the Act, having been filed in Case No. R-8, by United Automobile Workers Federal Labor Union No. 18347, the Board, on January 29, 1936, having issued a Direction of Election in the above case,¹ and, on February 28, 1936, having issued a Decision in the above case,¹ and, thereafter, International Union, United Automobile Workers of America, Bendix Local No. 9, having filed a petition, pursuant to Section 9 (c) of the Act, in *Matter of Bendix Products Corporation and International Union, United Automobile Workers of America, Bendix Local No. 9*, Case No. R-220, the Board, on September 16, 1937, having issued a Decision in Case No. R-220,² and it appearing that the Decision of the Board in Case No. R-220 concerned the issues raised by Case No. R-8 and that the same employees were involved in both proceedings, and the Board, on October 11, 1939, having issued a notice that on October 23, 1939, or as soon thereafter as might be convenient, it would dismiss the petition for investigation and certification of representatives filed in Case No. R-8 and close the aforesaid case, unless sufficient cause to the contrary should then appear, and no objections having been filed with the Board,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said petition be, and it hereby is, dismissed and that Case No. R-8 be, and it hereby is, closed.
