AMENDMENT TO DIRECTION OF ELECTION

*April 24, 1942*

On April 1, 1942, the National Labor Relations Board, herein called the Board, issued a Decision and Direction of Election in the above-entitled proceeding,<sup>1</sup> providing that an election should be conducted among certain employees of Portland Forge and Foundry Co., to determine whether they desire to be represented by Steel Workers Organizing Committee, affiliated with the C. I. O., or by the American Federation of Labor, for the purposes of collective bargaining, or by neither, and further providing that if any of the parties desired that the ballot provide for a different choice, request therefor might be made of the Board within five (5) days of the date of the Direction. Request for such a change having been duly made by the American Federation of Labor on April 4, 1942, the Board hereby grants the request and amends its Direction of Election by striking therefrom the words "the American Federation of Labor" and substituting therefor the words "International Brotherhood of Blacksmiths, Drop Forgers, and Helpers, Local No. 620, affiliated with the A. F. of L."
