CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

February 15, 1938

On January 17, 1938, the National Labor Relations Board herein called the Board, issued a Decision and Direction of Election in the above-entitled case.¹ The Direction of Election directed that an election by secret ballot be conducted among the warehouse employees of Blake, Moffitt & Towne employed at its Los Angeles, California, plant.

Pursuant to this Decision and Direction of Election, an election by secret ballot has been conducted under the direction and supervision of Towne Nylander, the Regional Director for the Twenty-first Region (Los Angeles, California) on January 31, 1938. Thereafter the said Regional Director, acting pursuant to Article III, Section 9, of National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations—Series 1, as amended, issued and duly served upon the parties an Intermediate Report on the election. No objections or exceptions to the Intermediate Report have been filed by any of the parties.

As to the balloting and its results the Regional Director reported as follows:

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that General Warehousemen's Local Union, chartered by Brotherhood of Teamsters, affiliated with the American Federation of Labor, has been selected by a majority of the warehouse employees of Blake, Moffitt & Towne at its Los Angeles, California, plant as their representative for the purposes of collective bargaining and that pursuant to Section 9 (a) of the Act, General Warehousemen's Local Union, chartered by Brotherhood of Teamsters, affiliated with the American Federation of Labor, is the exclusive representative of all such employees for the purposes of collective bargaining in respect to rates of pay, wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.
