AMENDMENT TO DECISION

AND

CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

*July 19, 1938*

On May 16, 1938, the National Labor Relations Board, herein called the Board, issued a Decision and Certification of Representatives in the above-entitled matter.<sup>1</sup> On May 20, 1938, Fairbanks, Morse & Company requested the Board to amend its decision in the above proceeding in the following particulars:

1. By striking from Section II of the Findings of Fact therein contained the following: "Steel Workers Organizing Committee, representing the Amalgamated in this case, is likewise a labor organization affiliated with the Committee for Industrial Organization," for the reason that the said finding is not supported by the record.

2. By striking from Section III of said Findings of Fact the word "consent" wherever it appears therein, unless it be made clear that the consent referred to is that of Pattern Makers Association of Beloit only.

After due consideration of this request, the Board hereby

AMENDS the Decision in the above-entitled matter, dated May 16, 1938, by striking out the words, "Steel Workers Organizing Committee, representing the Amalgamated in this case, is likewise a labor organization affiliated with the Committee for Industrial Organization," which appear as the second sentence of the second paragraph of Section II of said Decision.

FURTHER AMENDS the Decision in the above-entitled matter, by striking out the words "a consent election," which appear in the first sentence of the first paragraph of Section III of said Decision, and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "an election conducted by the Regional Director with the consent of the unions involved."
