

In the Matter of FLEXO PRODUCTS CORPORATION *and* INTERNATIONAL
BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS, LOCAL B-713

SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION

AND

ORDER

July 26, 1938

On June 24, 1938, the National Labor Relations Board, herein called the Board, issued a Decision and Direction of Election in the above-entitled case.¹ The Direction of Election directed that an election by secret ballot be conducted within fifteen (15) days from the date of the Direction among the production and maintenance employees of Flexo Products Corporation, including foremen, assistant foremen, foreladies, assistant foreladies, and shipping clerks, whose names appear on the Company's pay roll of February 17, 1938, and in addition the following employees: Michael Scoglielli, Mrs. O. M. Peterson, Joseph Restivo, John Szweide, Hugo Wyman, Muriel Hannor, and Cecelia Skanarak, excluding clerical and office employees and also Tony Bruno, Betty Stemper, and any other employees who have since quit or been discharged for cause, to determine whether or not such employees desired to be represented by International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local B-713, for the purposes of collective bargaining.

Pursuant to the Direction, an election by secret ballot was conducted on July 8, 1938, at Chicago, Illinois, under the direction and supervision of the Acting Regional Director of the Thirteenth Region (Chicago, Illinois). On July 11, 1938, the said Acting Regional Director, acting pursuant to Article III, Section 9, of National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations—Series 1, as amended, issued and served upon the parties an Intermediate Report on the ballot. No objections or exceptions to the Intermediate Report have been filed by any of the parties.

As to the results of the secret ballot, the Acting Regional Director reported as follows:

Total number eligible to vote.....	45
Total number of ballots cast.....	19
Total number of ballots cast for International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local B-713.....	5
Total number of votes cast against International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local B-713.....	14
Total number of challenged ballots cast.....	0
Total number of void ballots cast.....	0

The results of the election show that no collective bargaining representative has been selected by a majority of the employees. The petition for investigation and certification of representatives of employees of Flexo Products Corporation, Chicago, Illinois, will therefore be dismissed.

ORDER

By virtue of Section 9 (c) of the National Labor Relations Act, 49 Stat. 449, and pursuant to Article III, Sections 8 and 9, of National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations—Series 1, as amended,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition for investigation and certification of representatives of employees of Flexo Products Corporation, Chicago, Illinois, filed by International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local B-713, affiliated with the American Federation of Labor, be, and it hereby is, dismissed.
