Subject: Three-Day Posting Rule for Notices of Election

In OM 87-47, dated July 23, 1987, we advised the Regions that the Board had adopted a rule requiring that election notices be posted at least three days prior to an election. Inasmuch as the Board in the Supplementary Information statement accompanying the rule indicated that the Board agent should orally remind the employer of its notice posting obligation shortly before the notices were mailed, we instructed the Regions to modify the Election Order Sheet (Form 700) to include a line where the Board agent should initial to indicate that the agent had made the oral reminder. On December 23, 1987, the Board published in the Federal Register a clarification of the Supplementary Information Statement, substituting a written second reminder for the oral reminder. The Board further stated that the written reminder should be sent to the employer with the Decision and Direction of Election or the election agreement. The Board agent, therefore, is no longer required to orally remind the employer of its notice posting obligation. Accordingly, the Regions should make the necessary adjustments to accommodate the revised procedure.
