ORDER

On January 26, 2011, Administrative Law Judge Earl E. Shamwell, Jr., of the National Labor Relations Board issued his Decision in the above-entitled proceeding and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge found that the Respondent has engaged in certain unfair labor practices, and recommended that it take specific action to remedy such unfair labor practices.

officers, agents, successors, and assigns, shall take the action set forth in the recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge.
