Dear Mr. Heltzer:

I am writing as Counsel for the General Counsel to oppose Respondent Counsel's request for a further postponement from August 23, 2011 to "mid September" for exceptions to be filed with the Board in the above-captioned matter.

Since the granting of the Respondent's first request for an extension of time to file exceptions, Section 10(j) relief was granted by the district court on July 11, 2011. However, Respondent has thus far flaunted the court's order and there are pending motions currently before the federal district court which address that noncompliance.

Respondent's latest request for another month extension would only serve to further disenfranchise the affected employees who have been without justice since the trial date in early March. Further, Respondent's Counsel has already been afforded two extensions – one made at his request which providing him a month extension until August 19, 2011 and another caused by issues with the service of the ALJ decision. For these reasons, it is Counsel for the General Counsel's position that another postponement until some undefined date in "mid September" should be denied as it would also violate the tenets of Board Rule 102.94(a) which ensures that whenever Section 10(j) relief is sought, the case "shall be given priority by the Board in its successive steps."
