**ORDER TRANSFERRING PROCEEDING TO THE BOARD
and
NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE**

On July 22, 2011, the Charging Party filed with the Board a Motion for Summary Judgment on the ground that that the Respondent has admitted almost all material allegations of the complaint and that reinstating the laid off and transferred employees should not be further delayed. On September 15, 2011, the Acting General Counsel filed with the Board a motion in support of the Charging Party's motion, arguing that there are no genuine issues of material fact in dispute and that the Charging Party is entitled to judgment as a matter of law.¹

Having duly considered the matter,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C., and that the hearing scheduled for November 14, 2011 be postponed indefinitely.

¹ The Acting General Counsel asserts that there are factual issues with respect to the allegations in paragraphs 12 and 14 of the complaint and requests that these allegations be severed if the Board grants the Charging Party's Motion.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that cause be shown, in writing, filed with the Board in Washington, D.C., on or before November 2, 2011 (with affidavit of service on the parties to this proceeding), why the Motions should not be granted. Any briefs or statements in support of the motions shall be filed by the same date.
