1. The Administrative Law Judge's finding and conclusion that Respondent has a legitimate interest in preserving the confidentiality of the employees' identities. (ALJD p. 13, ll. 26-27; p. 14, ll. 12-13.)

2. The Administrative Law Judge's finding and conclusion that Respondent is required only to bargain in good faith to reach an accommodation of the Union's interests, rather than provide the Union with the requested information. (ALJD p. 15, ll. 20-22)
