SUBJECT: Conversion of Field Examiners to the Field
Attorney Position

After recent discussions with the NLRBU concerning field examiner details to attorney positions which could result in a permanent conversion to the attorney position, we have decided that examiners who are presently in their final year of law school or who have graduated from law school will, upon request, if justified by their performance, be given an attorney detail or an attorney conversion. As to all other examiners who are presently in law school or attend law school in the future, staffing considerations, operating needs, and all other relevant considerations will be taken into account when deciding whether to grant a request for an attorney detail or an attorney conversion.
