NOTICE OF LIMITED WITHDRAWAL OF EXCEPTIONS
TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE SANDRON’S DECISION**

Now comes the Respondent, Center City International Trucks, Inc., (“Respondent,” “Center City,” or “Company”) and pursuant to the terms of the February 14, 2012 settlement agreement entered into by and between the parties, hereby gives notice of limited withdrawal of its November 4, 2011 Exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Sandron’s decision (JD-52-11).

Specifically, Respondent hereby withdraws the following Exceptions: II, III, VI and VII as set forth in its November 4, 2011 brief. Exceptions I¹, IV and V are still before Board.

¹ Exception I (credibility) is necessarily still before the Board as Judge Sandron made certain credibility decisions with respect to Russell Mason’s alleged unlawful discharge and the Company’s alleged unlawful unilateral change in policy governing the re-employment of mechanics who re-acquire their CDL’s.
