



negotiations and, due to the availability of all parties to the collective bargaining agreement and the deadline in place for ratification of the same, negotiating sessions have been scheduled on Monday, June 4th, and Wednesday, June 6th. Accordingly, counsel for Beverly requires additional time to draft the post hearing brief in the above-captioned matter, and seeks a two week extension of time through and including June 21, 2012.

4. Counsel for Beverly contacted counsel for Local 150 and Counsel for the Party-in-Interest, Laborer's International Unions of North America Local Union No. 751, via e-mail and advised them of the nature of Beverly's request for an extension. Neither party has any objection thereto.

5. This request is brought in good faith and not for purposes of delay. No party will be prejudiced by the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, Charging Party, Beverly Environmental, respectfully requests an extension, through and including Thursday, June 21, 2012, for the parties to file post hearing briefs in this matter.
