**COUNSEL FOR THE ACTING GENERAL COUNSEL'S
MOTION TO MODIFY THE BOARD'S ORDER AS SET
FORTH IN ITS MAY 23, 2012, DECISION AND ORDER**


Pursuant to §§ 102.49 and 102.48(d)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the National Labor Relations Board ("Board"), Counsel for the Acting General Counsel hereby moves to modify the Board's Order included in its May 23, 2012, Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter, 19-CA-075174, as set forth herein.

1. In the first line of the Order, the Board inadvertently changed the name of Respondent such that it is at variance with the Board's caption and findings as well as the underlying pleadings. Accordingly, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel moves that the first line of the Order, which currently reads, "The National Labor Relations Board orders that the Respondent, Star West Satellite, Inc., Bozeman and Kalispell, Montana, and Idaho Falls, Nampa, and Post Falls, Idaho, its officers, agents, successors, and assigns, shall . . .," be corrected to read, "The National Labor Relations Board orders that the Respondent, Star West Satellite, Inc., its officers, agents, successors, and assigns, shall"

2. The Board's Order, at paragraph 2(b) erroneously limits posting to only five of Respondent's facilities, in contravention of: the Board's finding as to jurisdiction in "various offices and places of business," including, but not limited to, those named; the Board's certification of the underlying unit in 19-RC-15362 covering the breadth of Respondent's operations in approximately 10 or 11 facilities in three states (Montana, Idaho, and Washington); the Board's findings as to unfair labor practice conduct; and the underlying pleadings upon which the Board's findings were made. Accordingly, Counsel for the Acting General Counsel moves that the first sentence of paragraph 2(b) of the Order be modified to read as follows: "Within 14 days after service by the Region, post at all facilities, copies of the attached notice marked 'Appendix.'"


