¹ The Respondent contends, among other things, that the Board does not have a valid quorum under *Noel Canning v. NLRB*, 705 F.3d 490 (D.C. Cir. 2013) pet. for cert. pending, No. 12-1281 (filed Apr. 25, 2013), and *NLRB v. New Vista Nursing & Rehabilitation*, 2013 WL 2099742, -- F.3d -- (3d Cir. May 16, 2013), and therefore the complaint must be dismissed. For the reasons stated in *Bloomington's*, 359 NLRB No. 113 (2013), these arguments are rejected.
