**ORDER**

On April 24, 2013, Administrative Law Judge Eric M. Fine of the National Labor Relations Board issued his Decision in the above-entitled proceeding and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge found that the Respondent has engaged in certain unfair labor practices, and recommended that it take specific action to remedy such unfair labor practices.

The Respondent and the Intervenor filed timely exceptions to the Judge's Decision, and thereafter Counsel for the Acting General Counsel filed an answering brief. On June 28, 2013, the Respondent withdrew its exceptions, and on July 24, 2013 the Intervenor withdrew its exceptions.

Accordingly, as there are no exceptions pending before the Board, and the time allowed for such filing having expired,

Pursuant to Section 10(c) of the National Labor Relations Act, as amended, and Section 102.48 of the National Labor Relations Board Rules and Regulations, the Board adopts the findings and conclusions of the Administrative Law Judge as contained in his Decision, and orders that the Respondent, C & G Distributing, Co., Inc., its officers, agents, successors, and

assigns, shall take the action set forth in the recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge.
