DECISION AND CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

The National Labor Relations Board has considered objections to an election held May 14-15, 2014, and the Regional Director's report recommending disposition of them. The election was conducted pursuant to a Stipulated Election Agreement. The tally of ballots shows 11 ballots cast for and 8 ballots cast against the Petitioner, with 1 challenged ballot, an insufficient number to affect the results.

No exceptions have been filed to the Regional Director's report within the time provided. Accordingly, the Board adopts the Regional Director's findings and recommendations, and finds that a certification of representative should be issued.

IT IS CERTIFIED that a majority of the valid ballots have been cast for United Steelworkers AFL-CIO-CLC and that it is the exclusive collective-bargaining representative of the employees in the following appropriate unit:
