¹ Member Miscimarra and Member Johnson would grant review for the sole purpose of permitting Board review of *St. Vincent Charity Medical Center*, 357 NLRB No. 79 (2011), relied upon by the Acting Regional Director, where a two-member Board majority held that modified acute care hospital bargaining units need not conform to the Board's rule regarding acute care hospital bargaining units when an *Armour-Globe* self-determination election may add certain unrepresented employees to an existing non-conforming unit that pre-dated the Board's rule. However, in the absence of a three-member majority to reconsider that precedent, which controls disposition of this case, they agree to deny review.
