This is in response to your November 12, 2014 letter to Executive Secretary Gary Shinnars withdrawing the General Counsel's exceptions to the Decision of Administrative Law Judge John J. McCarrick in these cases, which issued on June 3, 2014. Your letter advises that Regional Director Frankl has approved the Charging Party's request to withdraw its charges in these cases, which are currently pending before the Board on exceptions filed by the Charging Party and the General Counsel. The Regional Director's approval of the withdrawal of the charges is conditioned on the Respondent's performance of undertakings in a private agreement between it and the Charging Party.

Your withdrawal of the General Counsel's Exceptions is **approved**. Further, in light of the Charging Party's withdrawal of its charges, the Charging Party's Exceptions are moot and will not be considered by the Board.
