Dear Mr. Fox:

This is in response to your January 26, 2015 Motion to Remand this case to the Regional Director for further processing, including granting the Union's request to withdraw its charge and dismissing the Complaint. Your Motion advises that, by letter dated January 6, 2015, the Union notified the Respondent that it was disclaiming interest in further representing the Respondent's employees, and subsequently, in correspondence with the Region, the Union requested withdrawal of the charge in this case, as well as in a companion case. In addition, your Motion states that there are no additional pending unfair labor practice charges involving the Respondent, and submits that further proceedings in this case would serve no significant remedial purpose.

Your Motion to Remand is **granted** and this case is remanded to the Regional Director for Region 18 for further appropriate action. Accordingly, the General Counsel's pending Motion for Summary Judgment in this case is moot and will not be ruled on by the Board.
