

VOTING UNIT

EMPLOYEES ELIGIBLE TO VOTE:

Those eligible to vote are: All full-time and regular part-time air cooled, commercial, industrial, multi paralleling systems, and master service technicians employed by the Employer at its Shelton, CT, South Windsor, CT, and Islandia, NY facilities who were employed by the Employer during the payroll period ending January 23, 2015.

EMPLOYEES NOT ELIGIBLE TO VOTE:

Those not eligible to vote are: All other employees, parts department employees, dispatchers, office clerical employees, and guards, professional employees and supervisors as defined in the Act.

Islandia, NY Facility

The election will be conducted in part by mail. The mail ballots will be mailed to employees employed in the appropriate collective-bargaining unit at the Islandia, NY facility from the office of the National Labor Relations Board, Subregion 34, on February 12, 2015. Voters must return their mail ballots so that they will be received in the National Labor Relations Board, Subregional office by close of business on February 20, 2015.

If any eligible voter does not receive a mail ballot or otherwise requires a duplicate mail ballot kit, he or she should contact the Subregional office by no later than 5 p.m. on February 17, 2015 in order to arrange for another mail ballot kit to be sent to that employee.

The mail ballots will be comingled with the ballots from the Shelton and South Windsor facilities and counted at the Subregional office located at 450 Main Street, Suite 410, Hartford, Connecticut at 10:00 am on February 23, 2015.
