Pursuant to Section 102.46 of the National Labor Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, Series 8, as amended, Counsel for the General Counsel hereby files the following exceptions to the ALJ's decision and order:

1. To the ALJ's failure to find that Respondent violated Section 8(a)(1) and (5) of the Act based on the rationale set out in Alan Ritchey, Inc., 359 NLRB No. 40 (2012) (ALJD 32: 23)
2. To the ALJ's failure to include in the recommended order that Respondent be

ordered to provide notice to and bargain with the Union consistent with Alan Ritchey. (ALJD recommended order)
