I am writing as a follow up to our recent discussion regarding treatment plans and consideration for possible epidural steroid injection procedure.

You have been scheduled for the procedure on Tuesday, August 11, 2015. Please arrive at 8:00 a.m. Remember; *do not eat or drink anything after midnight prior to the procedure.* You may take your regular medication in the morning with a sip of water. You must stop any anti-inflammatory medications or Coumadin five days prior to procedure. Again, stop taking any aspirin or Plavix seven days prior.

Prescriptions will not be given on the day of your procedure. Please call the office for any renewals. You will be at the facility for two hours. Please make arrangements for a ride to and from the facility.

Please allow 48 to 72 hours before resuming normal activities. No repetitive bending, or lifting in that period of time. Follow up in the office post procedure. If you have any further questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the office.
