DECISION AND ORDER

The National Labor Relations Board has considered objections to a mail-ballot election held from May 27 to June 11, 2014, and the Administrative Law Judge's report recommending disposition of them. The election was conducted pursuant to a Decision and Direction of Election. The revised tally of ballots shows 6 ballots cast for the Petitioner, and 5 ballots cast against the participating labor organization. There were 0 challenged ballots, an insufficient number to affect the results.

No exceptions have been filed to the Administrative Law Judge's report within the time provided. Accordingly, the Board adopts the Administrative Law Judge's findings and recommendations.¹

¹ The Administrative Law Judge dismissed the Employer's objections in their entirety, and recommended that the case be remanded to the Regional Director of Region 20 for the purpose of issuing the appropriate certification.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this proceeding is remanded to the Regional Director for Region 20 for further appropriate action consistent with the Administrative Law Judge's report.
