ORDER

On September 11, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Arthur J. Amchan of the National Labor Relations Board issued his in the above-entitled proceeding and, on the same date, the proceeding was transferred to and continued before the Board in Washington, D.C. The Administrative Law Judge found that the Respondent has engaged in certain unfair labor practices, and recommended that it take specific action to remedy such unfair labor practices.
