**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF THE RESPONDENT FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
RESPOND TO THE EXCEPTIONS OF THE GENERAL COUNSEL**

The Respondent hereby moves for a 14 day extension of time to respond to the Exception of the General Counsel in this case. These are the reasons for the Motion:

1. On September 8, 2015, the ALJ issued a decision recommending that the Complaint in this case be dismissed. On September, 14, 2015, the Board issued an order which set October 13, 2015 as the deadline for filing exceptions. Exceptions were filed on that date. Accordingly, Respondent's response to the Exceptions is due on October 27, 2015.

2. On October 12, 2015, Counsel switched law firms. The transition has been extremely time consuming. Thus, Counsel has been unable to fully prepare a professional response to the Exceptions of the General Counsel. Counsel therefore requests an additional 14 days to do so.

3. Counsel for Respondent has contacted Counsel for the General Counsel in this case and Counsel for the General Counsel does not oppose this requested extension of time.

4. Mr. Moore, the Charging Party, has been reinstated to his job. A short additional delay

in the resolution of this case will not prejudice his rights or the rights of the other parties to this case.

Wherefore, Respondent prays that the NLRB grant this Unopposed Motion for an Extension of Time to Respond to the Exceptions of the General Counsel to the date of November 10, 2015.


