Dear Mr. Breiteneicher:

We represent the Charging Party International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 158-C ("Union"). As you may recall, on December 8, 2015, your office granted the parties' request for an extension of time to file exceptions and a supporting brief to December 31, 2015 to allow the parties to engage in settlement discussions and collective negotiations. We were further advised that additional extensions would be available if the discussions and negotiations proved fruitful.

On behalf of the Union and Respondent Riccelli Enterprises, Inc. ("Riccelli" or "Employer"), I submit this letter to advise of the status of negotiations and to further request an extension of Respondent's time to file exceptions and supporting brief to January 15, 2016. As you are aware, in connection with Riccelli's request for an extension, Riccelli granted the Union recognition on November 2, 2015 and agreed to bargain in good faith with the Union. Since November 20, 2015, the parties have engaged in meaningful, good faith collective bargaining and settlement discussions. The parties have reached tentative agreements on a majority of the proposals and continue to negotiate in good faith to resolve all outstanding issues. The parties have agreed to finalize language proposals over the coming weeks and have also scheduled an additional bargaining session for January 7, 2016. Accordingly, the parties request that Respondent's time to file exceptions and a supporting brief be extended from December 31, 2015 to January 15, 2016.


