**ORDER<sup>1</sup>**

Saint Luke's Memorial Hospital's petition to revoke subpoena duces tecum B-1-OUQ23V is denied. The subpoena seeks information relevant to the matters under investigation and describes with sufficient particularity the evidence sought as required by Section 11(1) of the Act and Section 102.31(b) of the Board's Rules and Regulations. Further, the Petitioner has failed to establish any other legal basis for revoking the subpoena. See generally *NLRB v. North Bay Plumbing, Inc.*, 102 F.3d 1005 (9th Cir. 1996); *NLRB v. Carolina Food Processors, Inc.*, 81 F.3d 507 (4th Cir. 1996).
