Dear Mr. Breitenicher:

We represent the Charging Party International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 158-C ("Union"). As you may recall, on December 8, 2015, December 24, 2015, January 14, 2016, and January 28, 2016, your office granted the parties' request for an extension of time to file exceptions and a supporting brief to allow the parties to engage in settlement discussions and collective negotiations.

On behalf of the Union and Respondent Riccelli Enterprises, Inc. ("Riccelli" or "Employer"), I submit this letter to advise of the status of negotiations and to further request an extension of the parties' time to file exceptions and supporting brief to March 4, 2016. Since November 20, 2015, the parties have engaged in meaningful, good faith collective bargaining and settlement discussions and, as of January 7, 2016, the parties have reached a Non-Board settlement which we believe resolves all outstanding issues. The Region is currently in the process of reviewing the Non-Board Settlement and the Union's conditional withdrawal request of the Unfair Labor Practice charges. The Region is awaiting the matter to be transferred back from Washington, D.C. to Region 3. Accordingly, the parties request that Respondent's time to file exceptions and a supporting brief be extended from February 12, 2016 to March 4, 2016. We anticipate this is the final extension request and the parties will resolve the matter without further litigation.
