We have received your letter dated February 25, 2016, concerning the preservation of evidence relevant to the NLRB's pending petition for injunctive relief.

Consistent with the agency's obligations under the Federal Records Act, the NLRB will continue to preserve evidence it has collected from anticipated and potential witnesses, including Edward Sutton, and evidence it intends to use at the 10(j) hearing and at the trial of the underlying ULP. To the extent your letter asks the NLRB to preserve documents or electronically stored information not in its possession, custody, or control, such as documents solely in the possession of witnesses, including Edward Sutton, you should contact them directly regarding the steps you believe they should be taking to preserve evidence.
